Since March 10, 2022, the Committee has met once and resolved one additional matter via e-mail.

On May 18, 2022, Committee members agreed via e-mail to appoint M. Heller to the Patient Relations Committee. This was a time-sensitive appointment to allow the PR Committee to address an application for funding for counselling and/or therapy from a patient of alleged sexual abuse at the hands of a registrant.

At its June 8, 2022 meeting, the Committee discussed a detailed review of the statement of operations to March 31, 2022 and financial projections to 2024. The Committee will further consider the budget and strategic revenue-generating activities following the June Council meeting.

At the same meeting the Executive Committee considered a request from the Ontario Homeopathic Medical Association to meet with Council. Legal counsel will be consulted to determine if this matter can be addressed at a Council meeting, as the issue is not within the business of Council. The association will be invited to provide their report to Council by letter.
