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Discipline Hearing Summary

Sukhdev Singh Kooner (Maidstone, ON)

April 26-27, 2022

Details

On October 28, 2022, the Discipline Committee found that Mr. Kooner committed the following acts of professional misconduct:

1. contravening a standard of practice of the profession, in particular the Standards for Advertising and Vaccination;
2. failed to advise a patient to consult another member of a health profession within the meaning of the RHPA, where the member knew or ought to have known that the patient required a service that is beyond his scope of practice;
3. permitted the advertising of his practice in a manner that is false or misleading;
4. engaged in conduct or performed an act relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by members as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional; and
5. engaged in conduct that would reasonably be regarded by members as conduct unbecoming a member of the profession.

The findings arose from Mr. Kooner's conduct pertaining to a sign posted outside of his clinic pertaining to vaccination, engaging in discussion with a patient regarding advice on vaccination and issuing an exemption certificate related to COVID vaccination.
