Tip Sheet for the Jurisprudence Program

We are pleased to welcome you to the online learning module of the Jurisprudence Program. The learning module is supported by a handbook and a series of short multiple-choice quizzes.

The purpose of this program is to provide future registrants with a deeper understanding of the requirements to practice in a regulatory environment.

To increase your ease at completing the program, we recommond that you review both the Jurisprudence handbook and the learning modules. Downloading the PDF handbook and completing each online module, including the Reflection Questions throughout each lesson, will give you the opportunity to verify your knowledge and prepare you for the online quiz following each lesson. You may attempt the each quiz an unlimited number of times.

It is estimated that it will take you a minimum of 6 hours to complete the program.

Do I need any special equipment?

Yes, you will need speakers and/or headphones to listen to the modules. Closed captioning is also available.

Do I have to complete the program in one sitting?

No, you can leave and return to the program at any time. When you need to take a short break click the pause button at the bottom of the screen, then click the play button when you return.

Or you can simply log-out of the course and return by logging in again and selecting the lesson from the "Topic Outline". You may wish to make a note of where you left off, so that you can restart the next lesson easily.

You can also stop and then return to any in-progress guizzes by:

- going to the "Topic Outline",
- selecting the quiz, and
- clicking on Continue the Last Attempt.

If you are unsure which was the last quiz you completed, click on "View my progress".

Are the reflections questions and quiz marked?

The reflections questions are not marked and do not effect your score on the quiz. Reflection questions are part of the most of the online learning modules. These questions help ensure you understand the material and prepare you for the quiz. To answer the reflection questions, simply select the best answer and submit. The pop-up box will indicate if you got the answer right and provide you with additional information. You can only answer the reflection question one time, before moving on to the next slide. If you choose not to answer a reflection question, click the forward button at the bottom of the screen to move past an unanswered reflection question.

How is each quiz marked?

Each question earns one mark. The marks are gained or deducted once you select the "Check" box. If you get the answer wrong, a quarter-mark is deducted.

The quiz will tell you whether your answer is correct or incorrect and provide you with additional feedback.

You may continue to make another selection until you get the correct answer. Once you are satisfied with your answer click the "Check" button, then select the "Next" button to move to the next guestion.

Once you are satisfied with all of your answers within the quiz, you must click the "Submit all and finish" button to get your final score.

You can repeat all of the quizzes as many times as you like. Your final mark is based on your highest grade received.

You will successfully complete each quiz by achieving a mark of 80%. For the final quiz, comprising of 9 questions, all questions must be successfully answered.

How can I improve my mark on a quiz?

You can go back and review your past attempts and then re-attempt the quiz as many times as you wish. Your marks are recorded in order to provide you with feedback on your performance. Your passing mark is based on your highest grade received.

Is the final module different?

Yes, the final module and quiz focus on the entry-to-practice competencies tested through the Jurisprudence Program. The results of Quiz 17 form one part of the Individual Assessment Program. Both the Jurisprudence Program and the Individual Assessment Program are requirements of the Registration Regulation.

I have changed my email address what should I do?

Log in to the module and change your address under "My Profile, Edit Profile".

I can't view the Jurisprudence handbook

Make sure you have Adobe Reader installed on your computer.

I have completed a quiz but this is not shown on my progress report.

Go back to the guiz and check that you have clicked the "Submit all and finish" button on the guiz summary page.
