

## Executive Committee Report

### College of Homeopaths of Ontario (CHO)

Wednesday, November 25, 2020 (Teleconference)

**Purpose of Meeting:** To consider a change in fees for the registration of professional health corporations, review the proposed 2020-2021 goals and objectives, and to address other items to advance the work of the College.

#### Items Covered:

1. Received report from staff on the status of registration, noting that the College is on track to exceed targets set for the current fiscal year.
2. Received and approved report from the Registrar on the 2020-2021 Statement of Operations to October 31, 2020. To be presented to Council on January 28, 2021 for ratification.
3. The Committee reviewed an update on the progress of strategic goals and objectives for 2020-2021.
4. The Committee approved a change to the fee for registration of health professional corporations. The proposed change will be taken to Council in January 2021 for ratification, to be followed by a 60-day public consultation prior to implementation.
5. The Registrar reported that the CHO offices would be vacated in December 2020 and that staff would continue to work remotely. It was agreed that the issue of a permanent address should be revisited in three to six months when more is known about what other Colleges are doing and the long-term impact of COVID-19 on both needs and opportunities.
6. In light of the move to remote work, the Committee was presented with a document describing the College's various systems and identifying vendors and administrators.
7. Committee members considered issues related to interprofessional collaboration, agreeing that a lack of effective collaboration could be considered a public protection issue but that the College's role in attempting to address it is unclear. It was noted that growing Ministry emphasis on system partnerships suggests that an increase in engagement at the College level could be useful. It was decided by consensus that the topic will be pursued as a priority during the 2021-2022 fiscal year.
8. The President and Registrar offered thanks to Eden Gajraj for his many years of service to the College.
